| Methods | What did you do? | Baseline Analysis, investigation, Improvement design and implementation |
| Results | What did you find? | Outcome, monitoring plan |
| Discussion | What does it mean? | Lessons learned, barriers, what worked, what didn't work, next seps |

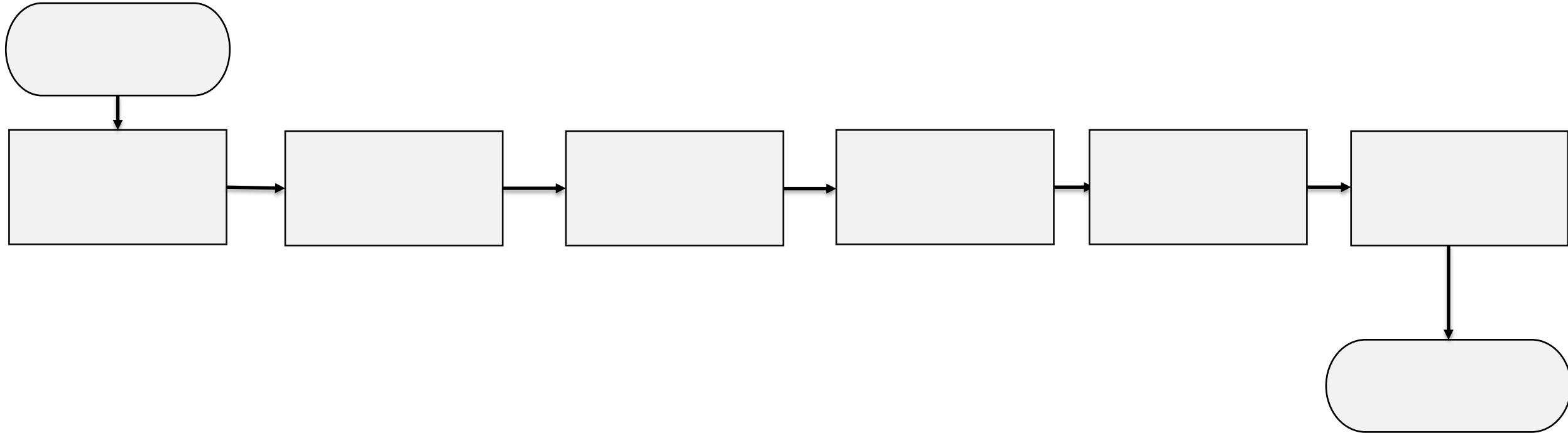

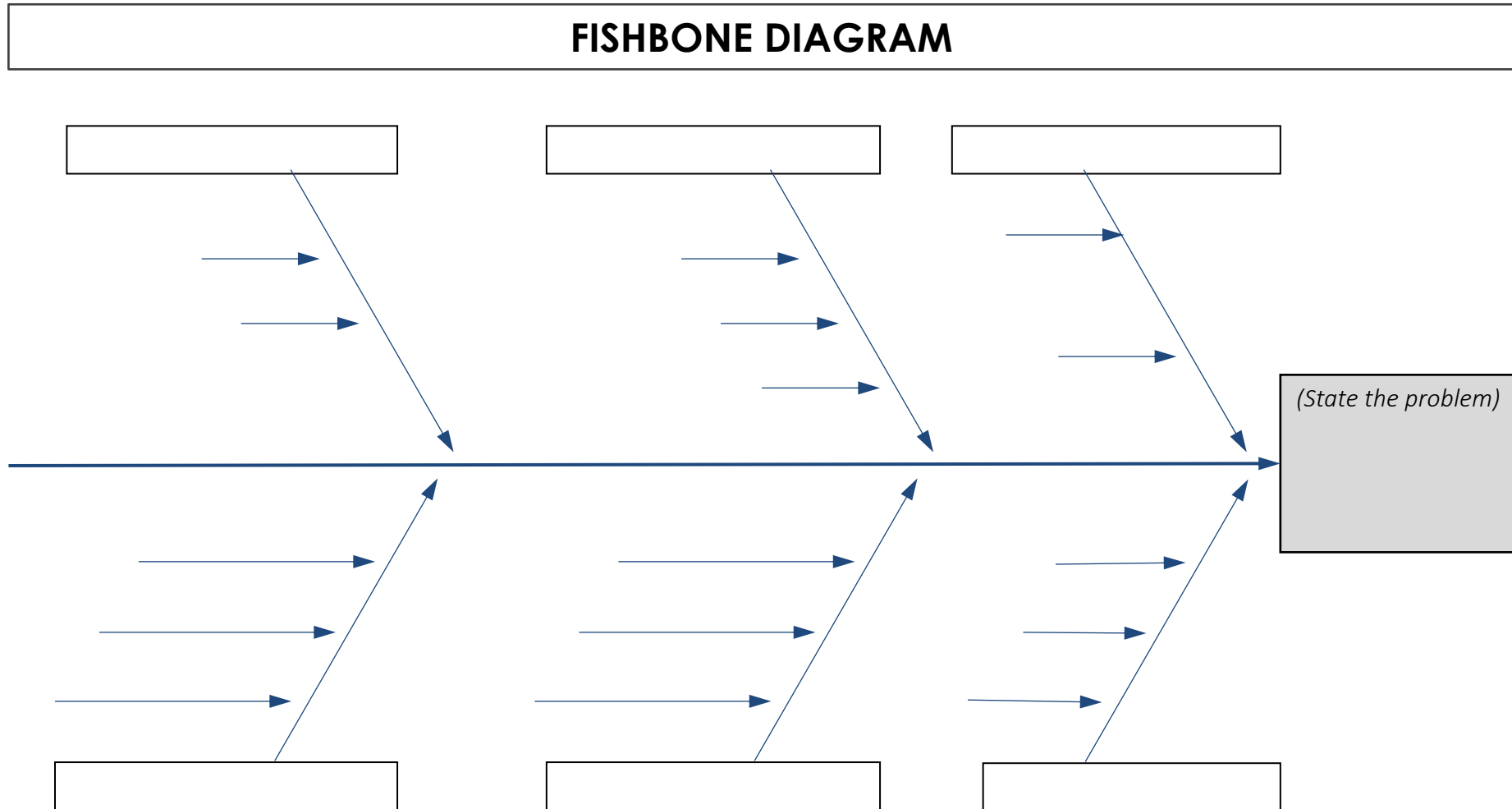
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CURRENT STATE PROCESS MAP
